Meeting in Trnava, Slovakia 10-16.11.2019

The topic of the LTT was "wars and immigration", Slovak Government's practices for Refugees, Integrating Students from Different Origins to Slovak Education System.

The students collaborated, and practiced group learning, they did observations, they provided an interaction, the students were promoted an active participation.

Before the LTT, all the students searched for the Second World War and Civil Wars in the history. And they interviewed with veterans. The program was :

- Day 1 : All participants were welcomed by the vice mayor of Trnava. after that they participated at the memorial celebration of the finishing of the 1st World War. Meeting continued at school. The students did presentations of their countries. Then, they were given free time to introduce themselves.
 - Host school presented their practices for refugees, and their immigrant students. We interviewed the veterans of Balkan war.
- Day 2 : Meeting for the partner countries to present the meaning and nonsense of the wars, the effects with General Macko. Multicultural discussions.
- Day 3 : The conference about the Second World War and its effect on Slovakia' and Europe's population structure in The museum of Slovak national uprising in Banská Bystrica.
 - Meeting veterans of World War II
- Day 4: A visit to Concentration Camp and holocaust museum in Sered',
 - The groups discussed about their impressions about the camps
 - The groups prepared brochures against wars
 - The groups discussed how to stop wars with the youth's view
- Day 5 : Brochures were exhibited to other students and teachers at the host school. (involvement and interaction of all students)
 - Each group gathered interviews and pictures via videoshow
